### **Guidelines for Contributors**

Contributions for the Journal are invited from the persons belonging to every walk of life having interest in Public Administration, democratic institutions and development process. Contributors are requested to send their article/research papers, research notes, book reviews etc in hard copy, typed on A4 size paper with 1.5 space in MSW format and the soft copy addressed to the Editor, should be sent on the following email address:

Those contributions which are received by April shall be considered for Jan-June issue and those which are received by October shall be considered for July-December issue. The contributors are also supposed to furnish the duly filled in 'Authors Declaration' format available on the website - <[www.iipabiharbranch.org](http://www.iipabiharbranch.org)> click **Journals** Tab.

The length of the research paper for submission should normally not be less than 3000 words and more than 5000 words, however, the special papers by reputed authors will have no such restrictions. Apply universal reference pattern, preferably 'end-notes' and intext referencing with bibliography at the end. The write-up must contain an abstract (less than 200 words) and should provide at least five key words.

There is a section of 'book reviews, research notes and impressionistic notes' which should be of the length of around 1500 words. The senior bureaucrats may also send their experiences of public administration.

Please note that papers are published after review by referees.
